OUR FAITH JOURNEY

Today is Ash Wednesday, the start of Lent. The children have had the opportunity to receive ashes during our whole school liturgy to mark this special day and as a sign of our commitment to continue in our journey of faith. Over the coming weeks we will be supporting the work of CAFOD as well

as our own local food bank in Billingham. The CAFOD appeal this year is "Turn Little Fish into Big Fish." The children took part in an assembly last week led by Margaret Hodgson, a local CAFOD volunteer, where they learnt about the way CAFOD partners have trained up people to set up their own fishing businesses and the impact this has had on their lives. On Friday 10th March, as well as enjoying Fairtrade Breakfast, children are invited to bring some silver coins into school to decorate some fish-shaped templates. The money we collect will be sent to CAFOD—our little actions can make a really big difference to people living in poverty.

Our Mini-Vinnies would also like to help people locally too and are asking for contributions for the Billingham Food Bank. Items such as orange juice/squash, sugar, long life milk, pasta sauce, tinned meat, rice pudding, fruit and custard, tea, coffee also toiletries (loo roll, shower gel, shampoo) and household cleaning stuff can be brought in to school and placed in a box in the hall.

Please continue to share the Wednesday Word at home which supports our Lenten journey. During the final week of term the children will plan and lead
