Dear Parents/Carers,

Our swimming this term will take place in the weeks beginning Monday 14th October and Monday 21st October, therefore the children will need their swimwear every morning for the fortnight.

We will inform you of when the children will attend in the Spring Term as soon as we are given that information.

On swimming days children will need to bring the following into school:

- Swimming costume (one-piece for girls, trunk/ lycra shorts not baggy shorts for boys)
- Swimming hat
- Towel
- Coat

Verrucas must be protected with either a sock or Bazuka type gel. Jewellery, watches and elastoplasts are not allowed in the pool. There is no need to bring shampoo or soap. **Any children with inhalers must bring them - please note that any child who is registered as having an inhaler will not be allowed to go swimming if their inhaler is not in school.** It is the responsibility of parents/carers to ensure inhalers are not out of date. If your child has long hair, it must be tied up to enable the swimming cap to be put on easily.

Children are discouraged from wearing goggles as they are not recommended, however, if this is a problem and will cause your child any distress please write to us confirming that you **'accept full responsibility for any accidents or injuries that may occur due to wearing goggles'**. Please note this EXACT wording must appear in your letter.
